

Bilston High Street Link

Draft Development Brief

Proposed to be adopted as a Supplementary Planning Document following a period of public consultation.

The principal objective of the draft development brief is to make clear the means by which the City Council would like to see the creation of a high quality pedestrian route between the Black Country Route and the High Street. This includes the site presently occupied by nos, 8-22 (evens) High Street, Bilston, West Midlands together with an area of land which crosses Pinfold Street Car Park (to form part of the proposed pedestrian route from the Urban Village to the High Street). The brief envisages the creation of new retail units on the ground floor with either office or residential accommodation (or a combination of the two) on the first and second floors. The brief anticipates the acquisition and demolition of nos. 8-20 to enable the new development to take place together with the acquisition and refurbishment of no.22

The period during which representations on the draft brief may be made runs from October 30th until December 11th 2008.
