ADOPTION STATEMENT UNDER REGULATION 19
OF THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING
(LOCAL DEVELOPMENT)(ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2004

Wolverhampton City Council adopted the Development Brief for the Bilston High Street Link as a Supplementary Planning Document on 29th January 2010.

Any person aggrieved by the Supplementary Planning Document may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for Judicial Review of the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Document. Any application must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months after the date on which the Supplementary Planning Document was adopted.

Copies of the Statement of representations made on the draft Development Brief (the "Consultation Statement") setting out a summary of the main issues raised and how they have been addressed, the adoption statement and the Supplementary Planning Document are available for inspection during normal opening hours at the Regeneration and Environment Services Reception Desk 24, Civic Centre, St Peter's Square, Wolverhampton and (by prior arrangement) at the Offices of the Bilston Development Project, 10, Caledonia Street, Bilston, WV14 6AE
